- 2010 Emiliana Sauvignon Blanc, Bio Bio Valley** £16.10  
Pungent and grassy with strong aromatic grapefruit flavours, crisp and appealing finish with fresh acidity.
- 2008/9 Tabali Special Reserve Chardonnay, Limari Valley** £26.60  
Golden yellow, fresh, intense with mineral aromas and elegant hints of honey and citrus fruits. Touch of oak adds complexity with a crisp, dry and flinty finish. Wonderfully balanced.
- 2009 Adobe Gewurztraminer Organic Cahapool Valley** £19.60  
This delicious wine from Emiliana Organico's biodynamic winery at Los Robles is full of rose-petal and grapefruit aromas with spicy juicy fruit and good acidity on the finish.

- 2010 Tabali Reserva Viognier, Limari Valley** £22.00  
Crisp and fresh with delicate peach and apricot flavours and a hint of spice.

- 2008/9 Taltarni Three Monks Fume Blanc, Pyrenees, Victoria** £28.90  
A vibrant explosion of melon, tropical pineapple and passionfruit with a hint of citrus lime and a clean refreshing finish.
- 2008/9 Keith Tulloch Semillon, Hunter Valley New South Wales** £30.40  
Juicy freshness on the palate with crisp clean citrus flavours and a subtle honeyed silkiness on the finish.
- 2009 Keith Tulloch Chardonnay, Hunter Valley, New South Wales** £28.90  
Aromas of melon and toasted nuts, it is vibrant flavourful and concentrated reminiscent of Premier Cru Chablis.

Citrus, mineral and waxy. Classic Riesling characters of honeysuckle, lemon and a long dry clean finish.

## Spain

- 2009 Albarino Orballo , Bodegas La Val, Rias Baixas** £25.00  
Generous on the palate with a weighty leesy texture and ripe fruit balanced with a refreshing smack of acidity.

- 2009 Artesa Viura, Bodegas Artesa, Aldeanueva, Rioja** £17.70

## Italy

- 2009 Pinot Grigio I Mastri Vernacoli, Trentino** £20.40  
Floral aromatic character, nice spice and reasonable depth of weight.
- 2009 Gavi "La Battistina", Azienda Agricola La Battistina, Gavi** £23.00  
Rich, ripe poached pear character, hints of peach with zingy acidity, minerality and immensely long finish.

## France

- 2008 Philippe Girard Sancerre Silex, Domaine Michel Girard, Loire** £35.00  
Lively, expressive with pronounced minerality and a long, long finish. Fantastique!  
(Sommelier Wine Awards 2010 Silver Medal Winner.)
- 2008/9 Pouilly Fume, Domaine de Maltaverne** £32.20  
Ripe and concentrated gooseberry fruit with hints of citrus and tangy herbaceous edge, finishing with mineral characters and crisp dry length.
- 2008 Chablis Vieilles Vignes, Domaine de la Motte** £33.30  
Produced from vines with an average age of 40 years Bernard Michaut makes top flight Chablis.
- 2007 Gewurztraminer Vieilles Vignes Turckheim, Alsace** £30.30  
Made from 35 year old vines this wine has an intense and engaging bouquet followed by rich kiwi fruit juicy apple notes and a dash of lychee.

### South Africa

- 2010 Percheron Old Vine Cinsault, Western Cape** £16.50  
Made from 65 year old bush vines, deeply flavoursome, gently compelling yet exotically spicy.
- 2006 Le Riche Cabernet Sauvignon, Jonkershoek Valley – Stellenbosch** £33.00  
Full bodied and aromatic with layers of clean sweet cedary oak. Supple richness and succulent on the palate with firm tannins and an underlying structure and fruit that promises even more complexity.
- 2008 Circle of Life Red, Waterkloof** £35.00  
A classically styled wine with notes of cassis and cedar. A true expression of the Waterkloof Estate.

### Chile

- 2009 Emiliana Merlot, Rapel** £16.10  
Packed with blackberry and plummy fruit, herbaceous and peppery nose, the palate shows dark fruits and ripe cherries with a hint of chocolate and coffee.
- 2008/9 Tabali Pinot Noir Special Reserve, Limari Valley** £26.60  
Delicious mouthwateringly delicate with smokey strawberry fruit, fresh citrus acidity providing the backbone and a gentle soft silky finish.

- 2009 Reserva Malbec, Bodegas Nieto Senetiner, Mendoza** £20.90  
Deep coloured powerful red with great concentration of berry fruit.  
Complex flavours of plums, figs and dried fruit with a smoky vanilla character.  
Great balance on the finish.

## Australia

- 2006 Three Monks Cabernet Merlot, Pyrenees, Victoria** £28.80  
Medium purple colour, aromas of dark berry fruits,  
cherry/raspberry and earthy characters. Lush fruits and  
vanilla flavours, complex structure with soft ripe tannins.
- 2008 Mr. Smith Shiraz, McLaren Vale** £28.50  
Rich blackberry and dark chocolate flavours underline a hint of spice  
Raspberry on the palate.  
(Sommelier Wine Awards 2010 Gold Medal Winner.)
- 2009 Fontys Pool Pinot Noir, Pemberton, Western Australia** £28.70  
Seamless earthy cherry fruit with generosity, elegance and authentic  
Pinot Noir character.

## New Zealand

- 2009 MOKOblack Pinot Noir, Central Otago** £28.00  
Pure lifted strawberry fruit with dusky spice and make this a Pinot Noir  
of style and provenance.

## Spain

- 2005 Vega del Rayo Reserva, Bodegas Carlos Serres, Haro, Rioja** £26.00  
Intense cherry red with a tawny rim, clean, powerful nose with aromas  
of sweet ripe red fruit and well integrated oak with soft velvety tannins –  
this is one exceptional Rioja!.

## Portugal

- 2006/7 Vista TN Reserva Figueira de Castelo Rodrigo** £22.80  
A very dark, brooding red with such appealing juicy black berry fruit.

## Italy

- 2006 Chianti Rufina Riserva Prunatelli, Toscana** £27.90  
A bright and aromatic spiced nose with lashings of sweet cherry fruit  
and a touch of dark liquorice running throughout.
- 2005/6 Salice Salentino Giardinelli Vineyard** £20.90  
Lovely bramble fruit, raisin and dried fig aromas and ripe juicy black  
fruit in the mouth with a hint of spice on the finish.  
(Sommelier Wine Awards 2010 Silver Medal Winner.)

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## France

- 2007 Clos De La Cure Grand Cru, St Emilion** £39.00  
Ripe dried fruit with smoky gamey edges, quite full-bodied and rich with a touch of oak, velvety tannins and fine length.
- 2009 Fleurie La Reine de l'Arenite** £26.40  
Ripe red fruit flavours with hints of strawberry and morello cherries. Full and firm grip on finish.
- 2008 La Chapelle du Marin Cotes du Rhone** £19.30  
The vineyards of this fourth generation Domaine are very close to Chateauneuf du Pape and share similar soil characteristics. Black fruit and liquorice flavours combine with a rich structure and soft supple tannins to create a hearty Southern flavour.
- 2004/5 Gevrey Chambertin Clos De La Justice, Vallet Freres** £62.00  
The most northerly of the world famous village in the Cotes de Nuits producing at its finest. Delicious, supple red berry fruit with elegance, integrated tannins and a long, pure Pinot finish.

## Rose Wines

- 2010 Circumstance Cape Coral Rose, Waterkloof Estate, Stellenbosch** £23.70  
From the red soils of Swartland hand harvested and pressed to bleed off the pale coral juice. Floral red fruit nose, a delicate attack that fills out to a lovely dry finish showing characterful lightness one could never tire of. (Sommelier Wine Awards 2010 Gold Medal Winner.)
- 2010 False Bay Rose, Western Cape, South Africa** £18.50  
A fruit-driven, slightly spicy pale rose with summer fruits on the palate and a lovely clean, dry finish.
